Saint Jerome. Today the Church remembers and celebrates Saint Jerome. One of the greatest Biblical scholars of Christendom, Saint Jerome was born of Christian parents in Dalmatia around the year 345. He visited Constantinople and became friendly with Saints Gregory Nazianzen and Gregory of Nyssa. He began to revise the Latin version of the psalms and the New Testament, with immense care and scholarship. Jerome eventually translated the whole of the Bible into the Latin version which is known as the Vulgate — the vernacular of his day.
